#### **Werner Buttner's "Plenty of Room for all Sorts of Happiness" at Marlborough Contemporary**

*May 24 through June 23, 2018*

The exhibition features new works created in the past two years together with a selection of paintings from the 1980s when Buttner gained worldwide popularity as part of a new generation of German artists. The works from 1981 -1989, with their dark imagery and paint handling are considered emblematic of their time. The new works will aim to highlight continuities as well as differences with the older works, which often presented a caustic view of contemporary society, politics, and art itself.
