Must Visit Art Shows in New York this Week: Roy Newell to John Akomfrah

The exhibition presents a selection of works by the Detroit-based artist MARGO WOLOWIEC (b. 1985, Detroit). "Though we perceive them as paintings, these works, ranging from modest in scale to immersive panoramas, are in fact loom-woven cloth infused with images via dye-sublimation

transfer,” the gallery says. The works feature images, forecast graphics and texts related to the recent storms and their devastating effects, underscoring the realities pertaining to the ongoing climate change. “In particular, Wolowiec connects the real-time subjugation of women in a patriarchal system to continued environmental debasement,” the gallery says, “Furthermore, correlating to their method of collection from online sources, the images illuminate the vulnerabilities of social networks and the media as magnifiers of false information regarding weather events and news in general.”
